

#### **FOREWORD**

Catch bulletins provide records of California's commercial fisheries and their value to fishermen. They also summarize the marine partyboat angler's catch.

The report for 1964 is the 24th in the series. Prior records have been published regularly beginning with those for 1926 and 1927. In recent years, catch bulletins have been published annually instead of biennially.

Records are obtained from each wholesale fish dealer or processor who receives fish from fishermen or who processes fish. Partyboat operators record each trip's catch, and these records are also sent to the Department. Clerical personnel in strategic locations (Eureka, San Francisco, Monterey, Terminal Island, and San Diego) maintain contact with fish dealers and local Fish and Game wardens to insure that the records are accurate and transmitted promptly. All data are edited and subsequently processed by electric accounting machines.

Published figures are of national and international concern, but they are used primarily by fisheries scientists and state legislators to manage and regulate California's important fisheries. Chambers of commerce, members of the fishing industry, educators, and others also find these catch statistics of value.

Special acknowledgement is given to the staff of the Biostatistical Unit who process the many documents necessary for this publication. The assistance of the wardens along the coast and the aid forthcoming from the many fish wholesale dealers and canners is appreciated.

# 1. EXPLANATION OF TABLES

The tables of this report summarize the statistics of various fisheries operations in California during 1964. In general, this report covers: landings of the commercial fishing fleet of California; sport catches of the partyboat fleet; imports of fish from other states or foreign countries that are destined for processing in California; deliveries to retail stores of bait used for sportfishing; and catches of boats that supply partyboats, skiffs, and yachts with live bait.

One of the most important fishery statistics we present is the total landings of each species harvested by California's fishermen. In addition, it is essential to know where and when catches are made. The tables therefore show the month and area of landing for each variety.

Data are not available for some of California's fisheries operations. For instance, fish shipped into California that are utilized in a fresh state are not reported to our Department. Likewise, sport fishermen aboard private skiffs and yachts, or fishing from shore or piers are not required to report their catches; however, the Department investigates the catch and effort expended in these activities.

#### 1.1. SOURCE OF DATA

Data on the commercial fishing fleet, bait deliveries, and imports are recorded on sales slips or receipts which are completed by fish dealers at the time of delivery. The receipts are transmitted to the Department twice each month. Each dealer is required by law to include on the receipt the following information concerning the transaction: weight of each species received; price paid to the fisherman; date; name of the fisherman; Department of Fish and Game registration number of boat; name of the dealer; and intended disposition of the fish (canned, fresh, etc.).

In addition, area of catch and type of gear used to catch the fish are reported for most landings.

The partyboat and live-bait boat catches are obtained from records or logs completed for each trip by the boat operator. The law requires skippers of partyboats to send records of their daily catches to the Department each month; however, the information received from the live-bait boats is given voluntarily.

The log of each fishing trip made by a partyboat contains the following information: count of each species taken; number of anglers; area fished; the number of hours fished; date; and boat identification.

Operators of live-bait boats report the number of net-sets and the number of scoops of bait sold each day. The species caught as well as the area fished are also given.

When fish receipts and fishing trip records are received, they are first edited and coded. The data are then punched into cards before being summarized with electric tabulating machines.

# 1.2. STATISTICAL AREAS

California is divided into seven areas for the purpose of reporting fisheries statistics. Each statistical area is named for a major port within its boundaries (Figure 1). Department personnel are responsible for collecting and inventorying landing receipts in each statistical area.

#### 1.3. SPECIES

The species of fish landed or shipped into California are listed in Table 2. Both common and scientific names are given. Some varieties are reported collectively when, for economic or other reasons, dealers do not report a specific separation.

One example of species grouping is the animal-food category which consists of a variety of fish caught by trawling. In an attempt to determine the species comprising animal food landings, a sampling program has been conducted by biologists of the Department's Bottomfish Investigation. Based on their findings, the estimated weight each species contributed to the 1964 animal-food category is:

# 1.4. CONDITION

Most fish and shellfish landed in California are in a round condition; however, some species, such as salmon and swordfish, are eviscerated or cleaned before landing. The condition of fish landed and shipped into the State cannot always be determined; therefore, the weights summarized in the tables are as reported to the Department without regard to condition.

Starting with 1963 records, the oyster poundage is published as packed gallon weight instead of live (in the shell) weight. The packed gallon weight of Pacific oysters is estimated to be 15.5 percent of live weight landings; that for Eastern oysters is somewhat lower at 10.9 percent.

#### 1.5. CONVERSIONS

Landings reported by units of measure other than pounds are equated to pounds by using appropriate conversion factors. Conversion factors

are determined periodically by sampling landings at delivery points. The factors applied to nine species during 1964 were:

# **1.6. VALUE**

Value is computed from prices paid to the fishermen. Values, therefore, reflect the contribution of the fishermen to the total worth of the fisheries. When the price paid for an individual landing is not specified, the average price for the species in the area in which it was landed is used.




FIGURE 2. Total annual landings and shipments into California. Includes sardine deliveries to reduction ships, 1930–38 (see Table 2).
