Fishkin Prize 2026 | *Application Details*

The Shelley Fisher Fishkin Prize for International Scholars in Transnational American Studies honors Professor Fishkin's outstanding dedication to the field by promoting scholarship that enables comprehensive and complex approaches to American Studies and which produces culturally, socially, and politically significant insights and interpretations relevant to Americanists around the world. The prize is awarded for publications that meet the following criteria:

- are authored **by scholars based at institutions located outside the United States or by international independent scholars** and
- have been published as **monographs, journal articles, or book chapters** (monographs or edited collections) and
- have been **published not earlier than three years prior** to the submission deadline.

The prize includes a three-year membership in the ASA and an electronic subscription to the *American Quarterly*, a cash prize, and an invitation to reprint (parts of) the respective publication in the *Journal of Transnational American Studies* (author is responsible for obtaining publisher's permission to reprint and for all copyright procedures). Publications by undergraduate and graduate students are not eligible. Coauthored works will not be considered.

Applications should include:

- one publication (full article; in case of monographs: introduction; contents; and a representative excerpt of no more than 50 pages not exceeding 8 MB)
- a two-page vita, including a selected bibliography
- a one-page abstract for this publication
