The *Journal of Law and Political Economy* seeks a freelance copy editor to support our team of scholars.

JLPE is an online, double-blind peer-reviewed scholarly journal, published two to three times a year on the University of California's eScholarship platform (<https://escholarship.org/uc/lawandpoliticaleconomy>). The only US-based academic journal dedicated to the Law and Political Economy movement, we promote work by scholars in law, the social sciences, and the humanities whose research seeks to expose mechanisms of structural inequality and promote economic, political, and social justice. The Journal's central goal is to explore power in all its manifestations (including but not limited to race, gender, sexuality, disability, and global inequality), and the relationship of law to state, market, and civil governance.

We seek a freelance copy editor who will prepare manuscripts for publication on an independent contractor basis. Compensation is \$25.00 per page, and our recent issues have ranged from 173 to 196 pages in length. This is a remote position; communication with the editorial team will occur via email, telephone, and Zoom.

Responsibilities include:

- Reviewing and revising content for accuracy and quality, including spelling, grammar, punctuation, and syntax
- Ensuring that all manuscripts conform to the Journal's style sheet
- Communicating and working with the operations teams to ensure that content is published in a timely manner

- Ensuring correct tone, voice, clarity, flow, and structure of content
- Updating and revising our style sheet as required

Successful candidates will have the following skills:

- Ability to manage multiple projects and consistently meet deadlines
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Highly organized and detail-oriented
- Familiarity with legal citation styles, including international legal citations
- Familiarity with the Chicago Manual of Style, 17th edition
- Proficiency in Microsoft Word
- Experience in publishing and/or editing
- Ability to learn and work with publishing management software databases
- Ability to work independently as well as in a team setting
