PROGRAM NOTES

List of instruments: Bass Drum, Tam Tam, 3 Gongs (small, medium, large and pitches corresponding to a C melodic minor scale), 2 Tom Toms, 2 Bongos, Metallic bar (for intense high sound), Crotales

Dont change mallets unless indicated.

Piano:

If pedal marking is introduced keep it pressed until next indication, whether to press it again or release it

Pay attention to the clefs!!

Strings:


Al pont. = right on the bridge
