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

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INTRODUCTION

Information on the organisms at proposed Ocean Thermal Energy Conversion (OTEC) sites is required to assess the potential impacts of OTEC power plant operations. To gather information on the distribution, abundance, and biology of organisms known to occur in OTEC regions, the Marine Sciences Group at Lawrence Berkeley Laboratory conducted literature surveys of those organisms. This bibliography is the product of a literature survey on marine mammals at a proposed OTEC site near Punta Tuna, Puerto Rico.

Included in the bibliography are reports of mammal sightings and strandings from Puerto Rico and adjacent Caribbean islands, reports containing information on distribution and abundance migration routes, and feeding ecology of those species known from the area. A few works on the general biology of marine mammals are also included.

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
