Clustering Plum Blossoms (2018) for violin and viola

This duet piece was dedicated to Yu-Fang Chen and Mei-Chun Chen.

The plum blossom has been depicted as a symbol of oriental art and poetry of winter. There are six winter solstice terms during the entire 24 periods of years in the Chinese lunar calendar. Composer tried to describe six various characters, fragrances, and gestures of clustering plum blossoms in the winter season.

The changing the tone color and sonority is slowly approached as if the changing of the weather and the meanings of these solar terms. The entire piece is generally atmospheric, descriptive and sensational in an abstract and imaginative way.

Trill on a harmonic note and indicated note on the same string as fast as possible

* **L.H. Tremolo:** sustaining two notes (double stops) by R.H. playing harmonic notes on two different strings rapidly (like a tremolo) by L.H. opened strings A or D note will be heard


multiphonic sound

[7 + 13 + 6 harmonics]

Multiphonic sound is the combination of different harmonic sound. The pitches will be approximate.

In this example, it shows harmonic sound of the 7th, 13th and 6th on C string.

In general, playing multiphonic, left-hand provides light pressure and a medium-slow, fairly heavy bow stroke, further from the bridge than normal harmonic playing with right-hand. Basically, the bow stroke will be light, faster and closer to the bridge.


bow pressure, with slow bow



bow pressure: very heavy bowing, to produce harshing and noisy sound effect, unexpected or unstable harmonic sound may be heard

Vertical bowing: brushing the strings with bow hairs in a vertical movement
 Back and forth (sul tasto and sul ponticello)
 left-hand will be playing double stop with light-touching, different harmonic sound could be produced.
