Rhapsody for String Quartet is a through-composed musical story that traces its primary theme's journey through a variety of landscapes, battles, and adventures. This hero, as it were, meets a few like-minded but diverse friends along the way who reappear throughout the tale, sometimes to help and sometimes to hinder him, finally uniting with him at the end in an exciting finale.

While the piece is not necessarily intended to be interpreted programmatically, its form nevertheless could be likened to an adventure narrative with its linear development and emphasis on motivic recurrence. Set in a rich pandiatonic tonal idiom and guided by a Neo-Romantic aesthetic, the eleven-minute Rhapsody makes many virtuosic demands on its performers.
