INTRODUCTION 作品简介

Shanhai Fortress was built in the Ming Dynasty (1381) as the important gateway in the east of the Great Wall, which is located in Hebei province, China. It was named Shanhai Fortress because of its exclusively geographical location. *Shan* means mountain, *Hai* means Sea. Shanhai Fortress is situated between the mountains and sea. As a significant defense bulwark to guarding Beijing, it has been a military fortress since ancient times. Although it has experienced historically capricious change, it stands still firm as a mountain. Through the great momentum shown in this orchestral piece, I endeavor to display the magnificent appearance of the Shanhai Pass. The melodic material of this piece is based on the Hebei Opera, the Chinese traditional Opera in Hebei province.


