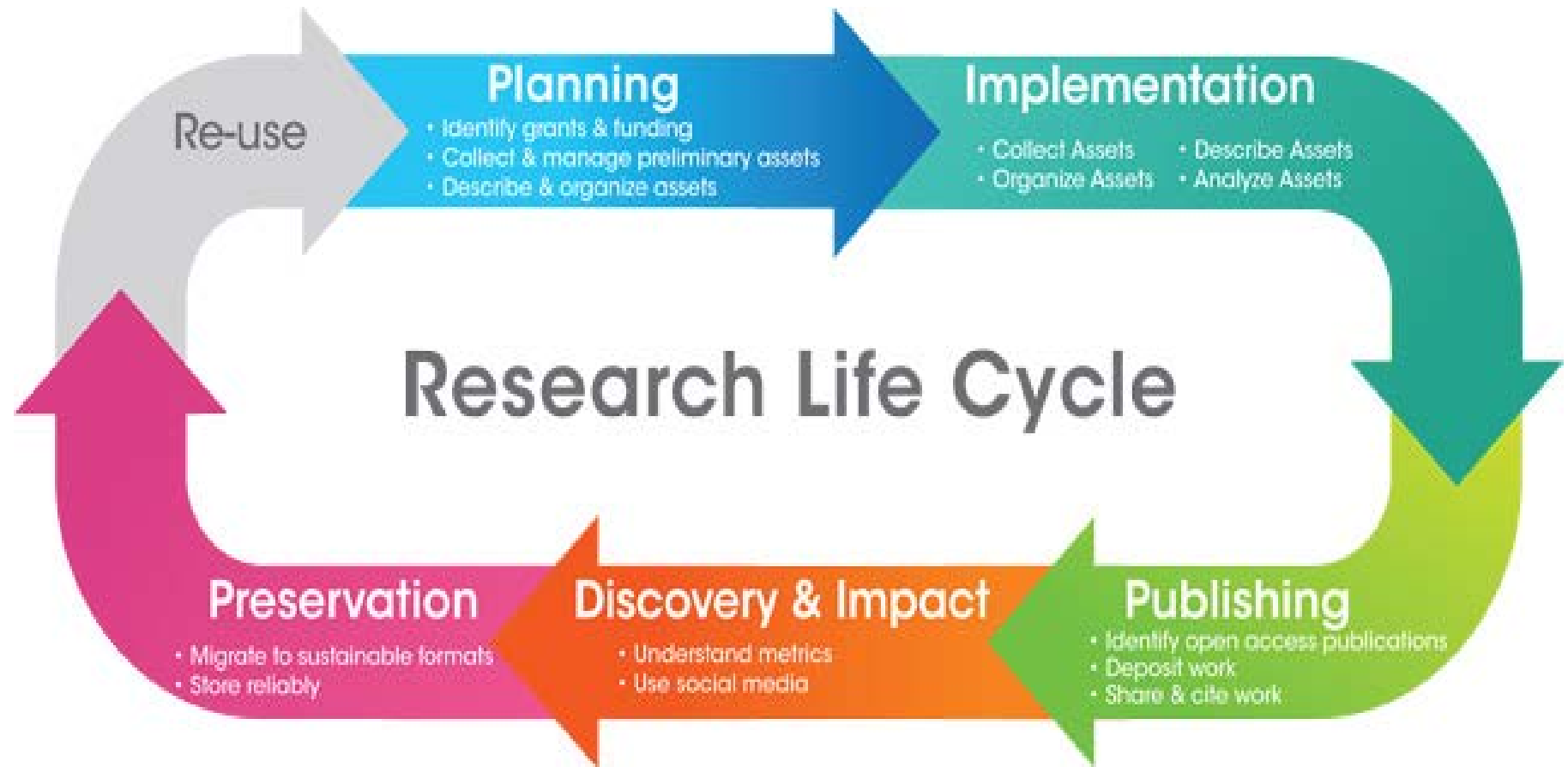

Data Sharing Landscape

- Federal regulations mandate researchers to describe how they are managing data to share when drafting grant proposals to NSF and NIH.
- UC has moved to an open access policy for faculty & employees publishing in journals but policy does not apply to data (yet)

Restricted Data

Restricted data are not openly available unless public-use files are made available. Access to restricted data is typically available only with a faculty sponsor and after filing paperwork and IRB approval. *UCI Libraries cannot acquire restricted data for you.*

Secondary Analysis

- Enabling secondary analysis of research data is the impetus behind data sharing.
- It benefits scientific inquiry because it tests if the research findings can be replicated or advanced. It is also less costly than going out and acquiring the data on your own.
- At UCI secondary analysis of data (e.g. from ICPSR) by researchers including students would typically undergo *expedited* [IRB](#) approval or disapproval.

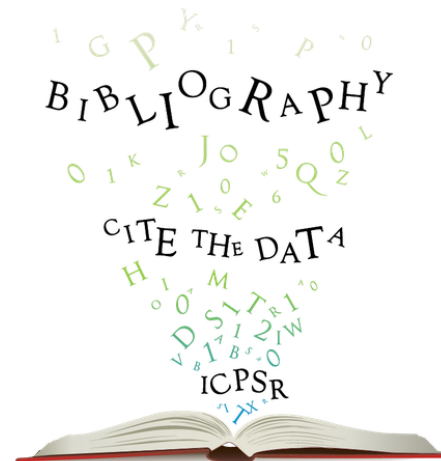

ABOUT RUBÉN G. RUMBAUT

- **Position:** Professor of sociology, University of California, Irvine
- **Research focus:** International migration, types of immigrants, inter-generational differences in adaptation, social mobility, bilingualism, ethnic identities, transnational ties, and more
- **Research direction:** Directed (with Alejandro Portes) the ongoing Children of Immigrants Longitudinal Study (CILS). Directed the first National Survey of Immigration Scholars in the US (NASIS). Directed several major studies of Southeast Asian refugees, including A Study of Southeast Asian Refugee Youth (SARYS) and the Indochinese Health and Adaptation Research Project (IHARP). Directed (with a University of California team) the Immigration and Intergenerational Mobility in Metropolitan Los Angeles study (IIMMLA). Directed (with John Weeks) major studies of infant health and mortality. Directed additional studies on topics such as immigrant students in California and transitions to adulthood in the second generation.
- **Most recent study:** (With Cynthia Feliciano) The Second Generation in Middle Adulthood
- **Currently working on:** Comparative Longitudinal Study of Educational Attainment and the Transition to Adulthood in Mexico and the United States
- **Publications:** Author of over 170 papers and coauthor or coeditor of 14 books

New Dissemination Platform

On January 12, 2015, to support the move to free data, the Fund introduced a new more user-friendly platform that will improve on-line dissemination.



The new platform can be found at data.imf.org

It comes with portals and dynamic visualization to showcase datasets which became available free of charge on January 1, 2015. The datasets are: International Financial Statistics, Balance of Payment Statistics, Government Finance Statistics, and Direction of Trade Statistics. They will complement other datasets which were already available on a new platform.

IMF will run both systems (the old eLibrary and the new dissemination system) in parallel for three months to help transition users to the new platform. Users will be guided through the change via self-help materials.

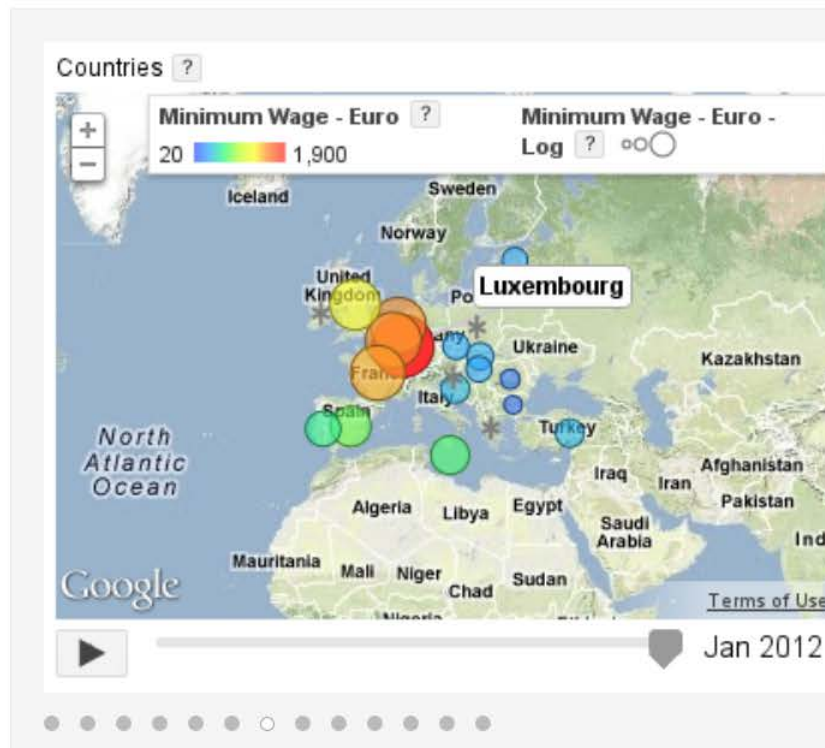

Minimum wage in Luxembourg vs. Bulgaria

Many European countries set minimum wages for gainful employment; these vary from slightly above 100 Euro per month in Bulgaria to more than 1700 Euro per month in Luxembourg. As low as the Bulgarian minimum wage is, however, this number has increased by more than 4x (in absolute terms) since 1999 as the standard of living in the country has improved.

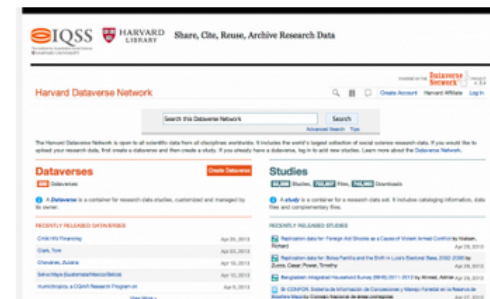

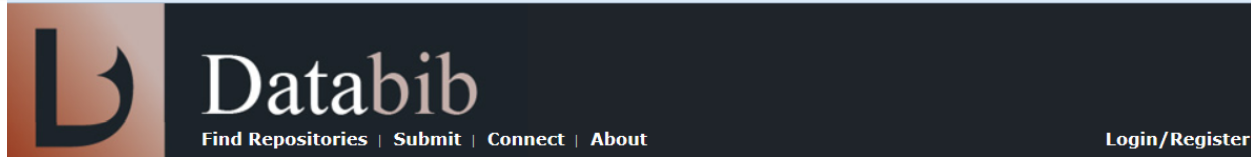
