Arrangements have been made, by the Docket, for a program of legal journalism whereby UCLA Law Students may submit articles for publication in the Metropolitan News.

The "News" is a legal newspaper which is published three times a week and reaches most of the law firms in the community.

The Law Schools of UCLA, USC and Loyola will each be allocated one day weekly for the publication of a student-written article. This will be a front page, by-lined article dealing with any topic of interest to the legal profession.

Dean Maxwell, in commenting on the "New" Docket recently said, "The Law Review fills the function of legal scholarship and research...Moot Court of legal advocacy, and now the Docket is providing the opportunity for development in the field of legal journalism, a field too often neglected by our Law Schools. Special techniques must be used in coordinating, describing and editorializing legal issues in journalistic style."

In line with this, the opportunities presented by participation in the Metropolitan News program are of even greater importance; in that it allows for presentation of the student's views, analysis or comments before a large legal audience.
