Crítica Hispánica is a journal devoted to scholarly articles and notes in Spanish and English dealing with Hispanic Literature and Linguistics. Submissions are referred by at least two expert readers. Articles should not exceed twenty typewritten pages (double-spaced) and should adhere in format to the *MLA Handbook*. Notes should be placed at the end of the text. In order to expedite an early decision, contributors should submit an original and two photocopies, accompanied by a self-addressed envelope and unattached stamps. The journal also has a book review section. A book will not be considered for review, however, unless the edition itself is sent for reading. Offprints can be purchased by contributors for a set fee. All rights remain with the author.

Crítica Hispánica appears twice a year, Spring and Fall. On occasion both issues may be published jointly. Claims for undelivered issues will be honored if they are received within six months of the publication date; thereafter, the single issue price will be charged. Advertising space is available. Exchanges with other journals are welcomed.
