Program Notes:

On the morning of 23 November 2009, the Maguindanao Massacre took place in the province of Maguindanao, Philippines. The victims, who were mostly media workers and the Mangudadatu family and supporters, were then on the way to file a Certificate of Candidacy for Esmael Mangudadatu before they were kidnapped and killed by members of the Ampatuan Family, the Mangudadatus' political rival. It is reported that 58 people were killed in the massacre; among those were 32 media workers and journalists, making the massacre the single deadliest event in the history of journalism. It was only until 2019, 10 years after the heinous crime, when the Ampatuans were found guilty and incarcerated.

This piece serves as my elegy to my innocent countrymen whose lives have been taken away because of this political rivalry. It also tries to be a statement for press freedom, and against the flawed and slow judiciary system that continues to deny numerous victims of the justice they truly deserve. As a Kulintang player, I tried to include Maguindanao in my piece by utilising variations of the Binalig Pattern, which is a Kulintang rhythmic mode from Maguindanao.




