## POLICY

The *Journal of California and Great Basin Anthropology* publishes five categories of written material: (1) articles, (2) reports, (3) documents, (4) comments, and (5) reviews. Provide *three* copies of all written material submitted for consideration. Manuscripts must be typewritten double-spaced throughout. Do not single-space *anything*, and do not use erasable bond paper. Keep manuscripts as brief as possible: articles (to 25 pages); reports and comments (under 10 pages); reviews (2-3 pages). Suggested page counts should include all illustrative material. Manuscripts submitted for consideration should conform strictly to the format of this issue. Authors may obtain a copy of the style guide by writing to the editor. Tables can ordinarily be set to type, but should be submitted double-spaced on one or more pages. Drawings and photographs should be of high quality. If possible, reduce drawings to conform with the single- or double-column format of the Journal, with ample room for captions. Submit captions on a separate page. References should be double-spaced and should conform to the style of this issue. End notes are permitted, but should be kept as brief as possible. All articles and reports submitted will be read by a committee of not less than four referees. Authors may receive reprints of their published papers at cost plus a nominal charge for handling and mailing. Reprints should be requested with the returned galley proof except for reprints of reviews (for which galleys are not provided), which should be requested at the time of submission.

## SUBSCRIPTIONS

The *Journal* is issued twice yearly in July and December. Subscriptions, when received by 1 March, are \$12.50 for individuals and \$15.00 for institutions. After 1 May, \$13.00 for individuals and \$15.00 for institutions. Each year, usually in December, the *Journal* also publishes a one-issue supplement, the *Journal of California and Great Basin Anthropology—Papers in Linguistics*. Subscription costs for those wishing to receive the linguistic supplement and the regular issues are \$17.00 for individuals and \$20.00 for institutions. Those wishing to subscribe only to the linguistic supplement may do so at the rate of \$5.50 for individuals and \$7.50 for institutions. Issues of the *Journal of California Anthropology* (predecessor of the JCGBA), except for Vol. 1, which is out-of-print, are available at \$6.00 for individuals and \$7.00 for institutions.

## ADVERTISING

Advertising space is available at the rate of \$90.00 per page (8 X 6¼ in.) and \$50.00 per half-page (4 X 6¼ in.) per issue. Advertisers must submit camera-ready copy reduced to fit the above dimensions, and remittance must accompany copy.
