Regarding the Composition:

The composition *Trio* for string quartet was written for the Iceberg New Music concert, and is dedicated to the Mivos Quartet. Inspired by the nature of the instrumental combination in a string quartet – three kinds of instruments as violin, viola and cello – the piece centers around the number “three,” on the basis of which the musical content and the formal structure is established. The piece also explores a sonic world which is not only created by the instruments themselves but is triggered by the essential movements as well as the surroundings.

Regarding the Performance:

Regarding the seating: face to the audience, from right to left is violin I, violin II, viola and cello.



The performers need to play from the printed parts.

A separate sheet of paper is clipped on each music stand.


The spoken words included in the music are pronounced in German.

Regarding the Staves:






Three lines of the staff indicate the playing position of the instrument: top to bottom, high to low.

Repeat the pattern which should be played as fast as possible.

O: open strings

f: fingerboard

b: bridge

bb: behind the bridge
