Program Notes:

Evanesce fabricates the hazy, immaterial, in-between state of passing through two distinctive physical realms, depicting anywhere from the literal phase change of a solid to a liquid, to the more abstract transition from life to death. In the face of this new unknown state, the piece begins with a quiet pensiveness, laced as much with hesitant uneasiness as it is imaginative wonder. The mysterious, icy ostinato figure in the middle of the piece creates the illusion of constant descent and eventually explodes into an agonizing cry of resistance towards what is to come. A calmer period of desperate nostalgia for the past soon brings us back to the opening inquiry, this time presented with a bit more stability yet still wrestling to find its ground within the desolate, elusive state of “the in-between.”
