Organic Plastic is a game of contrasts, meant to showcase the similarities and

differences between the two instruments.

The original idea for the music came from my fiancé, as she liked to give me

random combinations of words for inspiration somewhat jokingly. But this combination

stuck, as I had been recently studying Stravinsky's Rite of Spring and was particularly

intrigued by the effectiveness of his use of contrast throughout. The lyricism of the flute

melodies juxtaposed with the sinewy bass clarinet lines created the two characters to

draw from as well as the bulk of the musical inspiration.

The programmatic inspiration behind the work comes from the title itself, as is

meant to compare two vastly different and inherently opposed ideas as they are forced

to learn to occupy the same space and deal with one another. The flute represents the

natural world and presents lyrical pastoral themes while the bass clarinet is far more

industrial and gritty, represented by heavy chromaticism and angular rhythms.
