The American Philosophical Society was founded in 1743 by Benjamin Franklin and other leading thinkers of the colonial era as an independent scholarly organization dedicated to promoting useful knowledge in the sciences, humanities, and public affairs. As the oldest learned society in the United States, the Society brings together distinguished scholars, scientists, and public intellectuals to support research, preserve historical and scientific records, and encourage interdisciplinary dialogue on issues of national and global importance. Its programs, publications, and library collections contribute to the advancement of learning and to a deeper understanding of the cultural and intellectual heritage of the nation. Members are elected through a rigorous peer process in recognition of outstanding achievement and leadership in their respective fields.

The first woman elected to the Society was the Russian princess and intellectual Yekaterina Dashkova in 1789.
