

Performance Notes

Similar to painting with an ink brush, play sounds with refined physical movements on every part of the instrument. Begin and end the performance in the center. Freely repeat and hold motifs in any order. The overall effect reflects an understanding of the whole from a detailed focus on simple gestures through expansive variations. Inspired by the calligraphic impulse, gradations of texture reflect a depth of experience. Pitches in the Solos, Duo and final C# lift out of noise into emotion. X.1 to X.10 are chosen by chance. Relationships are non-linear.

Program Notes


Mò Shēng 墨声 Ink Sound is a work for string quartet that upholds scholarly ideals of self-reflection alongside engagement with shifting realities. Inspired by 18 ink paintings in the exhibition 潘公凯 Pan Gongkai: Withered Lotus Cast in Iron, the musical score opens western classical notation to be read in any order and repeated freely. Sonic gestures that vary fingering and bowing pressure relate to the variable densities of ink painting. These motifs can be read in any order by the string quartet, similar to how Pan's art work can be experienced. The music provides a template for realizing a calligraphic impulse; as brush stroke becomes painting, motion becomes sound.

The **Passenger String Quartet** is an avant-garde, experimental, neo-classical group, formed by Pacific Northwest composer/violinist Andrew Joslyn. The group is in high demand as studio session musicians, tours & performs original compositions, as well as backs a wide variety of regional and national touring groups such as David Bazan, DJ Spooky, Macklemore and Ryan Lewis, Suzanne Vega, and many more.



Byron Au Yong (歐陽良仁) composes songs of dislocation such as Kidnapping Water: Bottled Operas (Bumbershoot Festival of the Arts) and Occupy Orchestra 無量園 Infinity Garden (Chicago Composers Orchestra). As the son of Chinese immigrants in America, his catalogue includes Jì Mò 寂寞: The Stillness of Solitude (Portland Taiko), Piāo Zhú 飄竹: Flying Bamboo (Seattle Asian Art Museum) and Yíjū 移居 (Jack Straw New Media Gallery). Honors include a Creative Capital Award and Sundance Institute Time Warner Foundation Fellowship, as well as support from Aldeburgh Music in the UK and the Dragon Foundation in Hong Kong.
